Public Policy Education

- Provides direction and cooperates with other Associations on the Legislative Event.
- Serves as a delegate to the Public Issues/Leadership Development Seminar in alternate years.
- Encourages other members to attend at their own expense.
- Keeps Executive Board and members informed concerning legislation relating to Extension Service and Family & Consumer Sciences.

Public Relations

- Prepares and has newsletter printed (2 per year)
- Publicize the awards, scholarships and any other awards granted by the Association.
- Plan and arrange for news releases/publicity for Annual Meeting with Ag Communications.
- Cooperates with the Awards & Recognition Committee on the communication awards judging and planning recognition at the Annual Meeting.

Constitution & Handbook

- Reads and becomes familiar with the Constitution of the Association and the Handbook (information on website).
- Studies needed change in Constitution to better conform to NEAFCS.
- Obtains suggestion for changes from officers, committees, and task forces.
- Proposes such change in the Constitution as needed, and meets guidelines for announcing vote.
